questions.

1. What stood out most to you from the sermon? Revisit John 11:1-144
2. How do you feel about death? Even as a Christian. How do those around you, specifically, people who don't believe in eternity, view death?
3. If it were up to you, would you rather be saved BEFORE you need a miracle, or after?
4. The Miracle of Resurrection is on the other side of Death. How do you feel about that statement? How does that reality inform the miracles that you are praying for?
5. Re-read John 11:22. What does Martha's statement of faith say to you?
6. How does Jesus feel about death? What can you glean from John 11:23-36?
7. What do the attitudes of the onlookers teach us about their perspective on death in the light of Jesus' presence? (John 11:33-38)
8. Read 1 Corinthians 15:16-23. Why is resurrection the basis for God's power in our lives?
9. What might need to die in your life so that Jesus can do a resurrection?
10. What action might you need to do most from this week's message?
